1. No items may be sold from the ChowderFest cook-off area (including bottled water, t-shirts or food items other than prepared chowder.) But participating restaurants are encouraged to display restaurant menus and handout coupons for discounts or free appetizers.
2. Items that may be sold are limited to prepared chowder. Only after a free sample has been given, bowls of chowder may be sold for \$4 a bowl upon request or offered to repeat tasters.

(Entries received after the deadline are \$50.00 and based on space available.)

Waiver to use recipes: Chowder recipes must be made available in writing upon request and the winners may be printed in the newspaper.

REQUIREMENTS

Disposing of Oil & Waste Water will be the vendor's responsibility. ChowderFest will **NOT** provide oil refuse containers. Vendors must remove their oil from the site. No water is allowed to be dumped on ground. This includes ice melting and hand washing runoff. **Any vendor found dumping inappropriate material will be fined and immediately removed from ChowderFest.**

All propane tanks and other cooking devices must be protected from tipping over and unintended contact to people or clothing. All cooking devices and hoses must meet current Health and Fire Safety Code.

Fire extinguishers will be provided with tent/booth rental for cook-off participants.

Booths may be decorated tastefully and creatively, just remember that all materials must be non-flammable.
